**Restored Historic Thayer's Barn**



- ★ Raised \$212,000 to move and restore a 150 year old barn, now at Thayer's Corner Nature Area
- ★ Won 2007 award from the State of Michigan Historic Preservation Network for preserving Michigan history
- ★ Won 2008 Michigan Barn Preservation Network "Barn of the Year" award.
- ★ Raised \$34,000 to develop, along with Friends of Thayer's Corner Nature Area, the new community park on Napier Road, north of Six Mile Road.
- ★ Coordinated several Eagle Scout projects to enhance Veteran's Park and Thayer's Corner Nature Area
- ★ Negotiated with Pulte developers to delay some construction and provide \$264,000 to secure matching grant money for the development of Coldwater Springs Nature Area
- ★ Negotiated with Grand Sakwa for the gift of 16 acres for Ridgewood School and an additional 16 acres on the west side of Ridge Road
- ★ Received an award for \$5,000 for the Township in Washington, DC—from the National Association of Small Towns and Townships for our Community Park

- ★ Helped organize and chair the Friends of Northville Parks & Recreation (since 1992) - we pride ourselves in funding \$800,000 worth of improvements, such as:
  - Constructing restroom/ concession building in Community Park (\$250,000)
  - Providing over \$70,000 toward improvements at Ford Field and erecting its play scape.
  - Contributing \$18,000 toward refurbishing the tennis courts at Fish Hatchery Park, plus \$10,000 for its pond aerator/fountain
  - Contributing \$103,000 toward the completion of Bicentennial Park
  - Contributing \$16,653 to help develop Thayer's Corner Nature Area
